

The Lincoln Parish Police Jury met via teleconference on Monday, March 30, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. in accordance with the Governor's Proclamation Number JBE2020-30 allowing such meetings. Present were: Theresa Wyatt, District One; Hazel Hunter, District Two; Marvin Franks, District Three; T.J. Cranford, District Four; Logan Hunt, District Five; Glenn Scriber, District Six; Matt Pullin, District Seven; Skip Russell, District Eight; Joe Henderson, District Nine; Sharyon Mayfield, District Eleven; and Annette Straughter, District Twelve.

Absent: Milton Melton, District Ten

President Joe Henderson called the meeting to order. Matt Pullin delivered the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Sharyon Mayfield offered a motion, seconded by Theresa Wyatt, to approve the Agenda as presented. The motion was voted upon by roll call and carried with the following votes:

Following the interviews, Theresa Wyatt offered a motion, seconded by Hazel Hunter, to enter into executive session in accordance with State Law for the expressed purpose of discussing the professional competence of the applicants for the Parish Treasurer. The motion was voted upon by roll call and carried with the following votes:
